### BLAZERS

All pupils are required to have a Regulation Scarlet Blazer with badge, a Regulation Navy or Red Coat and a Regulation Cagoule (*to fit over the Blazer*). It is compulsory to wear them as below:

#### Autumn

*Half term 1 (Sept – Oct)* Blazers, with cagoules in school for wet weather

*Half term 2 (Nov – Dec)* Regulation Navy / Red School Coats to be worn

#### Spring

*Half term 1 (Jan – Feb)* Regulation Navy / Red School Coats to be worn

*Half term 2 (Feb – Mar/Apr)* Blazer or coat (*dependent on climate*)

#### Summer

*Half term 1 (Apr – May)* Blazers, with cagoules in school for wet weather

*Half term 2 (Jun – Jul)* Blazers, with cagoules in school for wet weather

### Girls - Winter (Autumn and Spring Terms)

- Regulation white round collar blouse
- Striped red/grey regulation tie
- Regulation grey tunic
- Regulation grey cardigan
- Red or mid grey (not light grey) thick, ribbed, three quarter length socks or red or grey tights (no leg warmers or over-the-knee socks)
- Black plain shoes with **low** heels, straps or laces. **No boot style or slip-on-shoes**
- Regulation scarlet woollen School hat. No other head-wear allowed
- Regulation scarf
- Wellingtons, if necessary
- Navy/scarlet gloves
- Hair ribbons, slides and bobbles in School colours

### Girls - Summer (Summer Term) – only difference to the above

- Regulation School summer dresses
- Regulation scarlet cardigan - V neck style
- White three-quarter length socks or ankle socks
- Regulation red or navy sun hat

### **Boys - Winter (Autumn and Spring Terms)**

- Regulation white long-sleeved shirt with collar
- Striped red/grey regulation tie
- Grey long trousers, cargo style trousers are not to be worn (shorts may be worn up until October half term)
- Regulation grey v neck pullover or v neck tank top
- Regulation scarlet woollen School hat. No other head-wear allowed
- Regulation scarf
- Mid-grey socks
- Black plain shoes (not trainer style)
- Navy/red gloves
- Wellingtons, if necessary

### **Boys - Summer (Summer Term) – Only difference to the above**

- White short-sleeved shirt with collar
- Grey shorts (Cargo style shorts are not to be worn) or grey trousers
- Regulation red or navy sun hat

### **P.E. Kit and Equipment - (all to be clearly marked with pupil's name)**

#### **Girls**

- Regulation OS polo shirt with Ockbrook logo
- Regulation OS regulation games skort or shorts
- 1 pair of white sports socks (ankle)
- School hockey socks - red with navy turnover (*optional Years 1 - 2*)
- School regulation uni-sex sweatshirt 'hoody' top
- 1 pair of sports trainers with laces
- 1 pair of football boots or old trainers – Spring Term Only (*Years 3 - 5 only*)
- 1 pair of shin pads (*Years 3 - 5 only*)
- Navy tracksuit bottoms or Regulation Skin bottoms
- Regulation Skin top (optional)
- Suitable Swimsuit (*Years 3 & 4 only*)
- Swimming cap and goggles (*Years 3 & 4 only*)
- Towel – named (*Years 3 & 4 only*)

#### **Boys**

- Regulation OS polo shirt with Ockbrook logo
- Regulation OS reversible football/rugby top with Ockbrook logo (optional)
- Regulation OS P.E. shorts
- School football socks - red with navy turnover
- School regulation uni-sex sweatshirt 'hoody' top
- Navy tracksuit bottoms or Regulation Skin bottoms
- Regulation Skin top (Optional)
- 1 pair of sports trainers with laces
- 1 pair of football boots or old trainers – Spring Term Only (*Years 3 - 5 only*)
- Plain trunks or swimming style shorts. No long Bermuda style shorts allowed (*Years 3 & 4 only*)
- Swimming cap and goggles (*Years 3 & 4 only*)
- Towel – named (*Years 3 & 4 only*)

### **Other Information**

Parents are requested to ensure that all items are labelled clearly with the pupil's name.

School raincoats/blazers must be worn for all School visits unless casual clothing is specified. Other coats are not allowed in School.

Hair should be worn off the face and tied back if longer than collar length.

For safety reasons no jewellery is allowed with uniform (including ear-rings)

A clear faced analogue watch, with a black, brown, red, white or blue strap is permitted.

Neither our Uniform Policy nor Responsible Use of Technology Policy allow primary pupils to wear Fitbits, smartwatches or other similar devices to school. They should not be worn by primary pupils.

Ear piercing must be done only in the Summer holiday so that healing takes place before School recommences.
