BLAZERS

All pupils are required to have a Regulation Scarlet Blazer with badge, a Regulation Navy or Red Coat and a Regulation Cagoule (*to fit over the Blazer*). It is compulsory to wear them as below:

Autumn

Half term 1 (Sept – Oct) *Blazers, with cagoules in school for wet weather*
Half term 2 (Nov – Dec) *Regulation Navy / Red School Coats to be worn*

Spring

Half term 1 (Jan – Feb) *Regulation Navy / Red School Coats to be worn*
Half term 2 (Feb – Mar/Apr) *Blazer or coat (dependent on climate)*

Summer

Half term 1 (Apr – May) *Blazers, with cagoules in school for wet weather*
Half term 2 (Jun – Jul) *Blazers, with cagoules in school for wet weather*

Winter (Autumn and Spring Terms)

Girls

- Regulation scarlet blazer with badge
- School regulation navy or red fleece lined waterproof coat
- School regulation Cagoule
- White long-sleeved shirt with collar
- Striped red/grey regulation tie
- Grey regulation knee length pleated skirt
- Regulation grey v neck pullover or v neck cardigan
- Black tights - 30 denier plus or Mid-grey thick ribbed three-quarter length socks
- Black plain regulation shoes (with low heels). **No boot style. No slip on shoes**
- Regulation school scarf
- Navy/scarlet gloves
- Hair ribbons or slides in School colours only

Summer (Summer Term) – Only difference from the above

- White short-sleeved shirt with collar
- White socks ankle or three-quarter length or flesh coloured tights

Boys

- Regulation scarlet blazer with badge
- School regulation navy or red fleece lined waterproof coat
- School regulation Cagoule
- Regulation white long-sleeved shirt with collar
- Striped red/grey regulation tie
- Grey long trousers
- Regulation grey v neck pullover or v neck tank top
- Mid-grey socks
- Black plain shoes (not trainer style)
- Regulation school scarf

Summer (Summer Term) – Only difference from the above

- White short-sleeved shirt with collar
- Grey shorts (Optional)

- Regulation OS games skort or shorts
- White sports socks (ankle)
- School regulation uni-sex sweatshirt 'hoody' top

- Regulation Skin top (optional)

Winter (Autumn and Spring Terms)

- School hockey socks - red with navy turnover
- 1 pair football boots

- Regulation OS reversible football/rugby top with Ockbrook logo
- Regulation OS P.E. shorts
- School football socks - red with navy turnover
- School regulation uni-sex sweatshirt 'hoody' top
- Navy tracksuit bottoms or Regulation Skin bottoms
- Regulation Skin top (optional)
- 1 pair of sports trainers with laces

Winter (Autumn and Spring Terms)

- 1 pair football boots
- 1 pair shin pads
- Gum guard (recommended)

General – All pupils

- Regulation School Bag. Please note, if the school bag needs replacing towards the end of Year 6, eg the Summer Term, it can be replaced by a suitable plain school bag in school colours in readiness for Year 7.
- Regulation Sports Kit Bag
- Boot bag (Optional)
- Art apron/overall/old shirt – long sleeves
- Calculator
- 1 pencil, 1 30 cm ruler, 1 rubber
- 1 dozen good quality pencil crayons for Art
- Pritt Stick
- Suitable handwriting pen
- Navy and white or red and white striped butcher's apron
- Food basket or other suitable bag for ingredients
- 1 named pair of round ended safety scissors

Other Information

- Parents are requested to ensure that all items are labelled clearly with the pupil's name.
- School raincoats/blazers must be worn for all School visits unless casual clothing is specified. Other coats are not allowed in School.
- Hair should be worn off the face and tied back if longer than collar length.
- For safety reasons no jewellery is allowed with uniform (including ear-rings)
- A clear faced analogue watch, with a black, brown, red, white or blue strap is permitted.
- Neither our Uniform Policy or Responsible Use of Technology Policy allow primary pupils to wear Fitbits, smartwatches or other similar devices to school. They should not be worn by primary pupils.
- Ear piercing must be done only in the Summer holiday so that healing takes place before School recommences.
