Pupils are expected to wear their blazers when coming to and from School. *In the case of extremely cold weather we appreciate that the blazer is not warm enough. On these occasions, a sensible warm coat in plain blue, black or red can be worn.*

PE Lockers

Other Information

For safety reasons the only jewellery allowed in School is a watch and a pair of simple ear-studs in the ear lobe.

Hair jewellery should not be worn and hair should be a natural colour. Extreme hair styles (eg. shaved patterns) are not permitted. It is expected that, in Years 7-11, hair will be tied back at all times.

Nail varnish is not permitted.

In Years 7-10, no make-up should be worn. As a Year 11 privilege, pupils are permitted to wear subtle, natural looking foundation only.

The Headmaster, Deputy Head and Senior Pastoral staff have the right to judge whether cosmetics and hair styles are appropriate for School and to ask for them to be altered if necessary.
